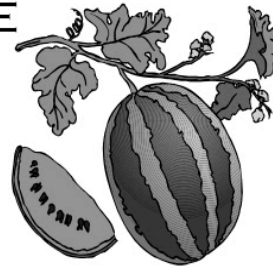

Stockdale Chamber of Commerce invites you to participate in our 72nd Annual Stockdale Watermelon Jubilee to be held Thursday, June 16, 2016 through Saturday, June 18, 2016 at the Stockdale City Park. For those of you who participated in the past, you know how great this event is. The Jubilee has a storied history and it has gained popularity over the past couple of years. It is a fun event for the entire family! We anticipate a large increase in attendance this year, as there will be entertainment in the park all weekend long.

On Thursday night we begin with a free admission event with a performance by **Cottonwood Crows and Waitin' on Hayden**; *Friday night* Pro Rodeo Pre-Show at 7pm and Rodeo at 7:30pm with Concert by **Reckless Kelly with Sunny Sweeney** until Midnight; and *Saturday* will feature an entire day of family fun starting with our downtown Parade, horseshoe/washer tournaments, live music, family entertainment, and shopping with our many vendors. Park entrance is free until 6pm. Saturday Rodeo Pre-Show begins at 7pm and Rodeo at 7:30pm with Concert by **Cody Jinks with Bart Crow** until 1am.

Booth space is limited, so submit your complete vendor package with payment as soon as possible!

CRAFT - BOOTH GUIDELINES
(These rules apply to ALL craft vendors – NO EXCEPTIONS)



- 1) The sale of craft items will be on the cash payment system. Organizations are responsible for getting their own change, and for handling the money or sales within their booth.
- 2) Organizations wishing to have/sponsor a craft booth for this year's festival will be responsible for paying the Stockdale Chamber of Commerce a **NON-REFUNDABLE booth fee of \$200.00**. Payment can be made via money order or cashier's check. **No personal checks will be accepted**. In addition, a **\$100.00 REFUNDABLE trash/cleaning deposit**. Payment may be made via personal check. Deposit may be returned within 10 days following said event. However, if booth guidelines are violated your trash/cleaning deposit will be forfeited and cashed.
- 3) **At check-in EACH craft booth will be provided 1 free admission pass for each night. Friday & Saturday after 6:00 PM there will be a \$25.00 charge per person if you would like to remain in the park area. You may purchase as many armbands as you like for \$15.00 at check-in or purchase pre-sale tickets prior to June 17th.**
- 4) Vendor booths will be limited to a 10'X15' space. Each booth will be required to furnish its own lighting (wiring and light bulbs) & extension cords (minimum 12/3). **Each space will pay \$25 per one (1) 110 volt (15 amp) electrical outlet**. If, you require more electricity, you must furnish it on your own (i.e., bring a generator) or if available, pay \$25.00 per outlet.
- 5) **Application with fees/deposits is due no later than Friday, June 8, 2016.**
- 6) ***Each vendor booth is required to furnish its own display equipment, and ALL tables MUST be covered and if possible, decorated using a "WATERMELON" theme!!!***
- 7) Each booth will be responsible for its own garbage cans and plastic bags. Receptacles must be emptied and your vendor area cleaned throughout the duration of the festival. Keep your area clean! There will be dumpsters nearby at all times.
- 8) There will be **absolutely NO parking** in the concession area. Driving in and around the vendor area will only be allowed during setup times, and under no circumstance will there be any vehicular traffic within the City Park between the hours of 6pm and midnight on Thursday (06/16) & Friday (6/17) and Saturday (06/18) between the hours of 9am until 1am (6/19). Vehicles should be used **ONLY** for loading and unloading. Violation of this provision will result in dismissal of your booth, as well as, forfeiture of the booth fee(s) and deposit.
- 9) There will only be security provided in the City Park until Midnight Thursday and Friday and until 1am on Sunday. The City Park is public place, but will be locked on Thursday and Friday nights.
- 10) Each organization will abide by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission rules at all times. All alcoholic beverages consumed at the festival **MUST** be purchased at the festival from the Stockdale Chamber of Commerce. No outside alcoholic beverages are to be brought into the grounds. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- 11) ***All items to be sold must be pre-approved by the Stockdale Chamber of Commerce. To omit any forfeiture, please be sure to list all items on your application.***
- 12) MUSIC will be allowed in or around vendor booths, but we ask that volume be kept to a minimum since we will have live entertainment continuously during festival hours. If too loud, you will be required to turn off.
- 13) The Stockdale Chamber of Commerce assumes **NO** responsibility for accidents or loss of any kind.
- 14) The Stockdale Chamber of Commerce is not responsible for the safety, health, or welfare of your owners, employees, family members, or other participants, nor are we responsible for the safety of your vehicles, booths, equipment, supplies, or property. Further, **YOU** agree to indemnify and hold the Stockdale Chamber of Commerce harmless from any and all claims, damages, or assertions of liability by any person or persons whatsoever arising out of or in any way related to any of your activities at the festival.
- 15) In the event that you have breached any of the terms of this agreement during the festival, the Stockdale Chamber of Commerce shall have the right (but not the obligation) to cancel this agreement, and to have you remove the booth, and all of your equipment and supplies immediately. Your vendor fee(s) and deposit will be forfeited.
- 16) The festival will be held rain or shine, so please bring necessary materials to keep your products protected.
- 17) ***A copy of your Sales Tax Number/License/Permit must be provided with your application.***

Hours of Operation: Thursday & Friday 6pm – 12am (midnight)
Saturday (free) 8am – 5:30pm & Reopens at 6pm – 1am (Sunday)

Tear Down: Vendors WILL NOT be allowed to tear down and leave the premises until after midnight on Thursday and Friday. Saturday you WILL NOT tear down until after the dance, which is scheduled to run until 1:00am on Sunday, unless prior arrangements have been requested & approved.
