Watermelon Jubilee Parade Rules

- 1) Parade begins promptly at 10:30 a.m. (RAIN or SHINE).
- 2) Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. All entries must be in place, set up and riders must remain in place until all judging is completed. Entries will not be judged if participants are not in place.
- 3) **NO** articles whatsoever (gum, candy, flyers, etc.) may be thrown, handed or passed out from any float or vehicle. This is a safety issue.
- 4) It is expressly forbidden for alcoholic beverages to be consumed by drivers or any participants before, or during, the parade. If a driver or participant is seen consuming alcohol while driving the parade route, it will result in removal from the parade formation.
- 5) Autos and large vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver. Small vehicles (mini-bikes, lawn tractors, etc.) must be operated by a person age 12 or older.
- 6) Parade participants are not permitted to leave vehicles to demonstrate/perform in the street or to slow the forward movement of the parade in any way.
- 7) When disbanding, units should not block flow of traffic for participants behind them.
- 8) Youth entries shall have an adult supervisor who will be responsible for his/her group following all parade rules. Adult groups/organizations should name a contact person.
- 9) Parking will not be allowed along the parade route. You may leave vehicles in the elementary or gym parking lots.
- 10) Exceptions to these rules may be made only with the approval of the Stockdale Chamber of Commerce -Board of Directors. The Parade Committee retains the right to refuse entry of any float, unit or individual not conforming to the high standards of the Stockdale Chamber of Commerce. Failure to comply with the Parade Rules may result in removal from the parade formation.

Release, Waiver of Liability and Covenant Not to Sue

As a result of any property damage or personal injury received by participating in the Watermelon Jubilee Parade.
